Woodson PTSA, the Fairfax County Park Authority, and the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors harmless from and against any and all costs, claims, demands, charges, liabilities, obligations, judgments, executions, costs of suit, and actual attorney's fees incurred or suffered by W.T. Woodson PTSA as a result of, or arising out of, the participant's negligence or misconduct; and
4. Authorizes W.T. Woodson PTSA to obtain or authorize any reasonable incidental and/or emergency medical treatment for the participant in the event the participant's parent(s)/guardian(s) are not readily located and participant becomes ill, injured, or incapacitated; parent(s)/guardian(s) hereby accept the responsibility to pay for such treatment.
